INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FOR MANUFACTURER REGISTRATION

- Legible document. In order to properly process and avoid a delay in processing the CNG Form 1001M all information must be legible. Forms which are not legible will not be processed and will be returned if possible.
- 2. Applicant's Company Name: Please list the exact legal name of the company. Be sure to include any suffix initials such as "Inc.", "LLC", or "L.P." if applicable. Please note that all business organizations in Texas must be organized under the statutes of the Texas Business Organizations Code before the Commission may issue a registration.
- 3. dba: "doing business as" (also referred to as assumed name filing). In addition to the legal name of the company, please list any additional names under which jurisdictional activities are or may be performed. All dba's must be registered as stated in item #4, and a copy of the appropriate assumed name certificate must be submitted with the registration application.
 - If the business entity is a <u>sole proprietorship</u> or a <u>general partnership</u>, an Assumed Name Certificate listing each assumed name must be on file with the county clerk in each county where a business premise will be maintained. If no business premise will be maintained, the Assumed Name Certificate must be filed in each county where business will be conducted.
 - If the business entity is a <u>corporation</u>, a <u>limited partnership</u>, or a <u>limited liability company</u>, an Assumed Name Certificate listing each assumed name must be filed with both the Texas Secretary of State and each county where the business will have an office.
 - Please keep in mind that Assumed Name Certificates are valid for a specific amount of time (usually 10 years) and must be renewed periodically. For additional information concerning the steps required to establish a business entity, please contact the <u>Governor's Office</u>, <u>Division of Economic Development and Tourism</u>.
- 3. Name and Address of Contact Person: Please list the name, mailing address, physical address and telephone number of the principal person we can contact if we have any questions concerning your registration or activities. All official communications from the Railroad Commission will be mailed to this person at this address. It is recommended that this person be a principal decision-maker within the company.
- 4. Type of Business Entity
 - <u>Sole Proprietorship</u>. Registration is non-transferable. If the sole proprietor leaves or dies, the registration immediately expires, and all jurisdictional activity must cease. A sole proprietorship with an assumed name must be registered with the county.
 - <u>Partnership</u>. Registration is non-transferable. If a partner leaves or dies, the partnership is immediately dissolved. A new registration is required to add or delete a partner. General partnerships are registered with the county. Limited partnerships and registered limited liability partnerships with assumed names are registered with both the Secretary of State and the county.
 - <u>Limited Liability Company</u>. Registration is non-transferable. LLC's are treated much like sole proprietorships, except that an assumed name is registered with the Secretary of State.
 - <u>Corporations</u>. Registration is transferable through sale of corporation, provided that the corporation remains active and registered with the Secretary of State. The two types of corporations are domestic and foreign. Domestic corporations are chartered by the Texas Secretary of State. Foreign corporations are chartered in states other than Texas or in other countries. The Secretary of State must register both types of corporations before a Railroad Commission manufacturer registration may be issued.
- 5. Is the registration applicant registered with the <u>Secretary of State</u> and authorized to do business in Texas? Select Yes or No.
- 6. Is the registration applicant a corporation, limited partnership, or limited liability company? These entities shall be approved to transact business in Texas by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. The applicant must submit a copy of the current Certificate of Account Status from the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts.

7. Company Ownership

Sole Proprietorship. List name and address of owner.

<u>Partnership</u>. List name and address of all partners. Partners may be individuals or business entities such as corporations or other partnerships. If partnership is classified as a Limited Partnership, please identify all general partners and limited partners.

Limited Liability Company. List the name and address of the owners.

<u>Corporations</u>. List the names and addresses of all corporate officers.

- 8. Type of Containers Manufactured: You may check one or more types of containers. You must be approved by the authority (American Society of Mechanical Engineers or US Department of Transportation) regulating the manufacture of the containers you are registering for.
- **9.** Are you applying to manufacture ASME containers? This question requires manufacturers of ASME containers submit a copy of their American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) with the registration application.
- **10.** Are you applying to manufacture DOT containers? This question requires manufacturers of DOT containers submit a copy of their U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) certificate of authorization with the registration application.
- 11. "Has your company's ownership or type of business entity changed?" Registration renewal applicants that have changed ownership of type of business entity may need to apply for a new registration. Review §13.67 to determine if a new registration is required, If so, make the necessary changes to CNG Form 1001M, and any other required forms, and submit the original registration fee indicated in §13.61.
- **12.** Insurance verification. For new registration applicants submit a copy of your Acord 25 form, or other form approved by the Texas Department of Insurance, showing the coverage required by §13.62 of the Regulations for Compressed Natural Gas. Applicants qualifying for statements in lieu of submit 1996B, 1997B and/or 1998B.
