## NOTICE TO PIPELINE OPERATORS

## Pipeline Damage Penalty Adjustments

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) will no longer offer penalty adjustments for *Stipulation, Agreed Settlement and Consent Orders* issued after September 1, 2019 for violation of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 18 relating to Underground Pipeline Damage Prevention.

The amount of any penalty will be determined by the RRC in accordance with applicable guidelines, prior to sending the operator the initial notice of violation. As outlined in the notice, the violations are subject to monetary penalties and obligate the operator to come into compliance with RRC rules. A copy of the *Stipulation, Agreed Settlement and Consent Order* will be attached to the notice.
