**ITEM NO. 7:** In addition to the provisions stated in Item No. 7 of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s rules and regulations, Texas R.R.C. No. 138, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

(1) The percentage deductions for crude petroleum 46 degrees API gravity and above will not apply to movements under this tariff, and (2) the deduction of two-tenths of one percent to cover evaporation and loss will not apply to movements under this tariff.
