Receipts From Tank Truck Facilities: In connection with trunk line movement of Crude Petroleum, the Carrier will undertake to receive same from tank trucks, provided all required racks and other special facilities at Carrier's points of origin are furnished by the shipper or consignee. An additional charge will be made for such service:

Pumpover Charge: A delivery charge of [C] cents per barrel of 42 U.S. gallons will be charged on all deliveries out of Carrier's terminal at Colorado City, Scurry County, Texas.

Viscosity Surcharge: In addition to all other charges for transportation herein, all Crude Petroleum having a viscosity greater than 72 Saybolt Universal Seconds (SUS) at 60 degrees Fahrenheit shall be subject to an additional charge of [C] cents per each unit change in viscosity above 72 SUS (rounded to the nearest one hundredth of a cent). Viscosity measurements will be based on Carrier's most recent published table of viscosities by Crude Petroleum type.

Exception to Texas R.R.C. No. 138, Rules and Regulations, supplements thereto or reissues thereof: The pipeline loss allowance of two-tenths of one percent specified in Item No. 7 of the rules and regulations will not apply to crude petroleum received by truck at Colorado City.

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
