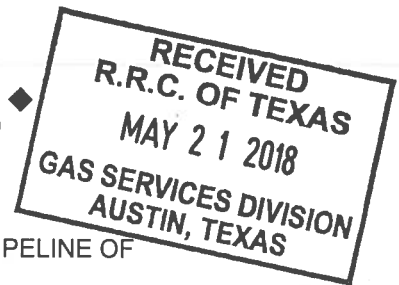


# PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P. ♦

## CRUDE PETROLEUM



The rate named in this tariff is for trunk line transportation of crude petroleum by pipelines, subject to the Rules and Regulations published in Plains Pipeline L.P.'s Texas RRC No. [W] 70 70.12.1, supplements thereto and reissues thereof ("Rules and Regulations Tariff").

No gathering service will be performed under this tariff, and the rate named herein is for trunkline transportation only.
