The rates named in this tariff are for the transportation of crude petroleum by pipeline, subject to the rules and regulations published in ExxonMobil Pipeline Company's Tariff Texas R. R. C. No. 89, supplements thereto and reissues thereof unless otherwise specified herein.

[N] Effective September 21, 2018, the Temporary Embargo at Choate Road is hereby cancelled.

~~Effective February 27, 2018, movements originating at Choate Rd. are temporarily embargoed. This is due to a temporary pressure reduction taken on the Webster to Baytown mainline that necessitates additional assessment of the Choate Rd. injection point prior to reinstatement. The embargoed movements are denoted by the symbol [E] under the schedule of rates on page 2. EMPCo requests that the temporary embargo remain in effect until a tariff filing is made canceling the embargo.~~

TERMS:

- The term "Monthly Volume" is defined as volume from any one shipper received at Reception Point in a Calendar Month.
- Rate "A" will be applied to first 180,000 barrels shipped in the Calendar Month.
Rate "B" will be applied to all barrels shipped in excess of 180,000 barrels in the Calendar Month.

CAPITAL SURCHARGE

- ^(a) In addition to the rate noted above, effective July 1, 2017, a capital surcharge of [U] 10.51 cents per barrel will be applied to the first 74,825,000 barrels accumulated by all Shippers for deliveries to Baytown. The surcharge will be removed once the required volume accumulation has been met.

TERMS:

1. The term "Annual" is defined as twelve (12) consecutive months beginning with the first day of the first month in which an initial delivery is made by Company to tariff destination and ending with the last day of the twelfth (12th) month in the consecutive 12-month period.
2. Company will invoice Shipper monthly at the appropriate rate as shown above. There are two rates, as follows:
 - Rate A, which applies to the first 9,125,000 barrels shipped Annually, and
 - Rate B, which applies to all barrels shipped in excess of 9,125,000.

GATHERING CHARGES

ExxonMobil Pipeline Company (EMPCo) no longer performs gathering services into any of the reception points listed in the table above.

Exception for volumes that originate from Oil Tanking at Moore Rd Junction - Any overages or shortages not due to the negligence of the Carrier, including losses for shrinkage, evaporation, in any calendar month, will be allocated on a monthly accrual basis among the shippers in the proportion that the total number of barrels delivered from Oil Tanking for each shipper bears to the total number of barrels delivered from Oil Tanking for all shippers.
