Pumpover Charge: There will be a pumpover receipt charge of [I] 17.25 cents per barrel for barrels received from Rangeland at Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Midland South, Midland County, Texas.

EXCEPTIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'S RULES AND REGULATIONS TARIFF:

Rule 40A: In addition to the quality specifications stated in Rule 40A of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations Tariff, the following quality specifications will apply:

- a. API gravity shall not exceed 44.0°.
- b. The sulfur content for WTI crude shall not exceed 0.45% by weight.

Rule 25C: In lieu of the nomination date provisions stated in Rule 25C of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations Tariff, the following will apply: Any Shipper desiring to tender Crude Petroleum for transportation shall make a Nomination to the Carrier before 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, on the fifteenth (15th) of the month preceding the movement. When the fifteenth (15th) of the month falls on a weekend, nominations will be required prior to 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, on the preceding Business Day. When the fifteenth (15th) of the month falls on a Carrier Holiday, nominations will be required prior to 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, three (3) Business Days prior to the Carrier Holiday. Unless such notification is made, the Carrier will be under no obligation to accept Crude Petroleum for transportation.
