Best Practices in Response to Winter Weather Forecasted This Week

The National Weather Service has indicated certain areas in the state will experience overnight temperatures dropping below freezing this week and early next week, followed by warmups during the daytime.

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) askes operators to monitor and maintain operations for potential impacts, as safety permits.
