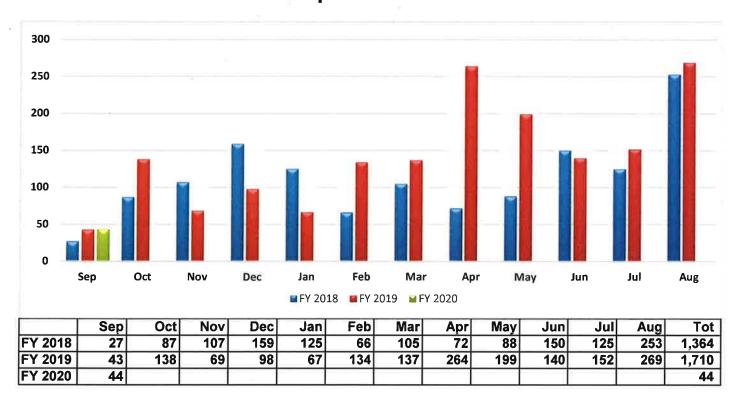

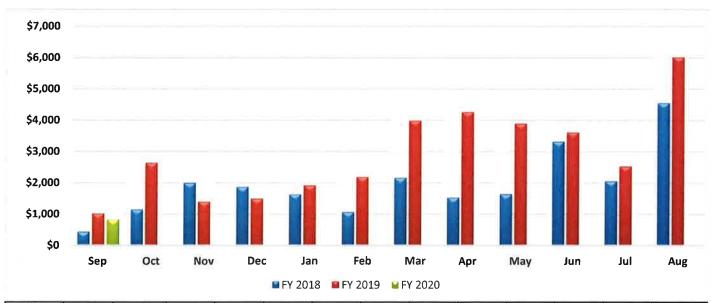

## State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Wells Plugged September 2019

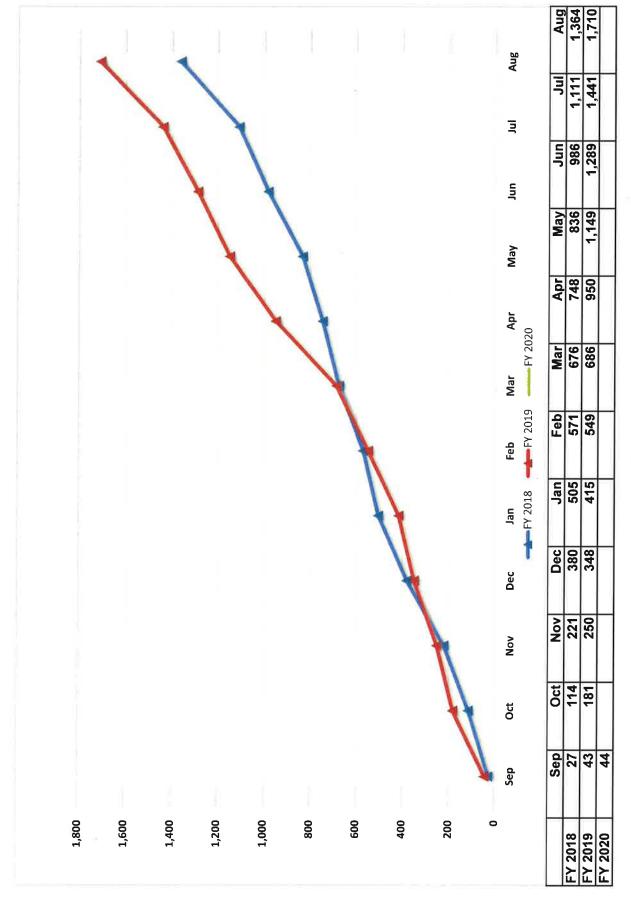


# State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Cost of Wells Plugged September 2019



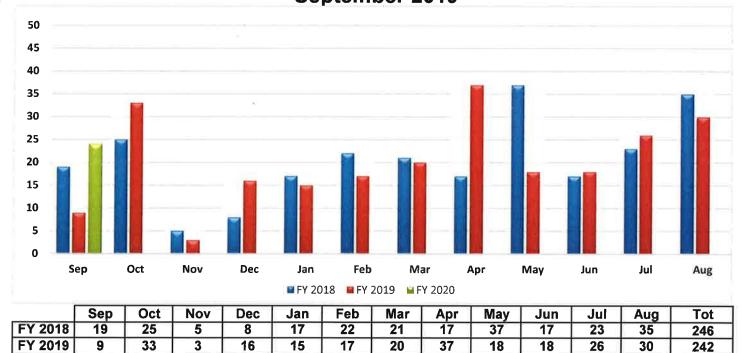

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## State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Salvage Operations September 2019

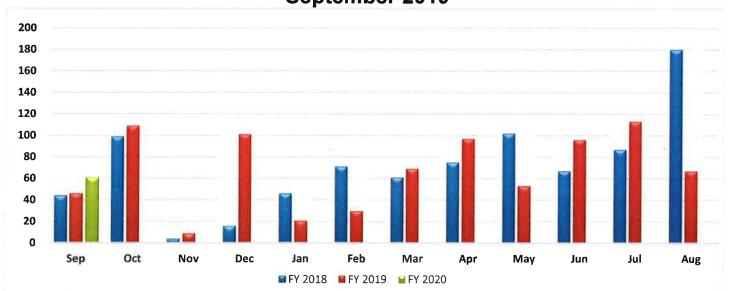

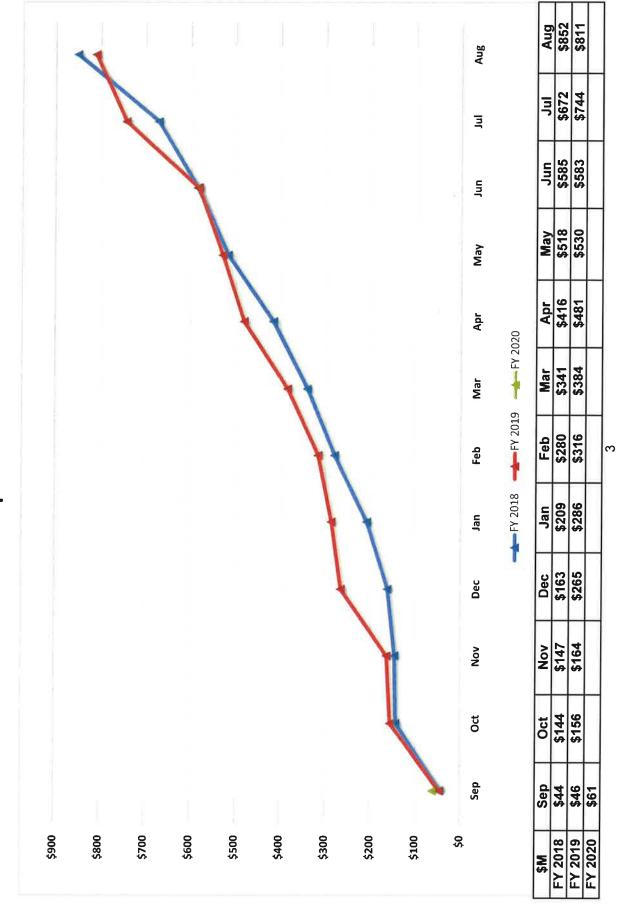
